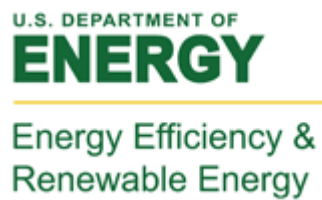

Her responsibilities are to assist with guidance development and implementing instructions for E.O. 13514.</p> <p>From 2003 to 2006, Leslie worked as a defense contractor, providing support to the Army and Navy on environmental programs, sustainability planning, and technology management. Since 2006, she has served as a civilian with the U.S. Army, where she managed agency-wide environmental technology programs; developed environmental cost models, reporting tools, and program budgets; and provided oversight for environmental policy.</p> <p>Leslie graduated from the United States Military Academy in 1994 with a B.S. in Environmental Engineering, and served for five years as an active duty Army officer in the Adjutant General's Corps. She received an M.S. in Civil Engineering with a focus on sustainable design and construction from Georgia Tech in 2002. In 2006, Leslie undertook a Ph.D. program in Environmental and Energy Management at The George Washington University.</p>
